“From Hens to the Holodomor” A National Speaking Tour for Andrea Chalupa

As the international community prepares to mark the 80th anniversary of the Holodomor this fall, the Ukrainian Canadian Congress National Holodomor Awareness Committee (UCC NHAC) and the Ukrainian Canadian Students' Union (SUSK) are proud to announce a national initiative to raise awareness of the Holodomor in the Ukrainian Canadian community as well as in the broader Canadian public.



American journalist Andrea Chalupa has written a book titled *Orwell and The Refugees: The Untold Story of Animal Farm*. The book is about a personal journey into her family's history, during which she found a Ukrainian translation of George Orwell's *Animal Farm*. The translation was authorized by Orwell himself and widely disseminated in the post-WWII Displaced Persons camps in Europe. Andrea has written this book making interesting connections to the Soviet Union and specifically, the Holodomor.

The UCC NHAC and SUSK have partnered to facilitate and coordinate a national speaking tour for Andrea Chalupa, which consists of book presentations in 8 cities across Canada. Local presentations are organized by UCC Provincial Councils and Branches together with Ukrainian Students' Organizations.

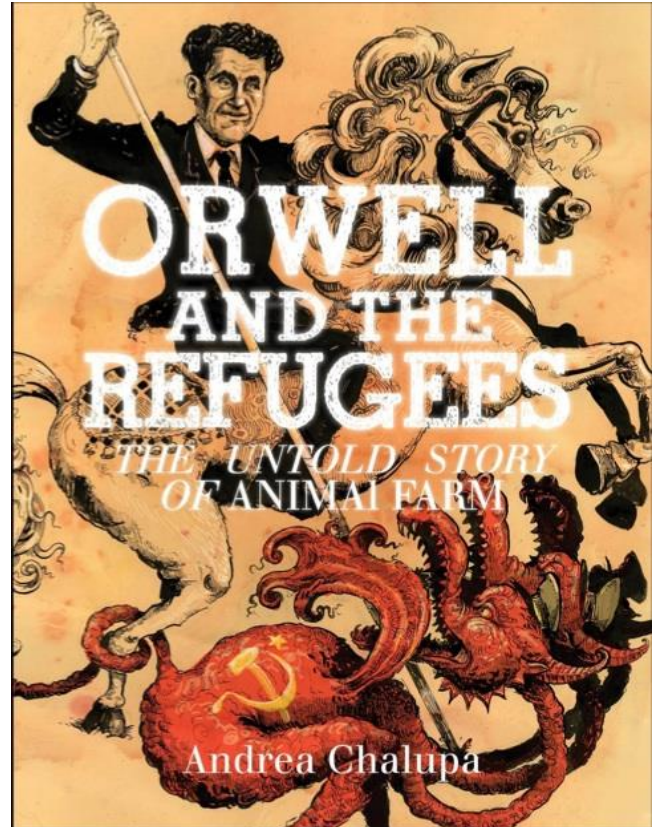
